- Dissemination and marketing strategies for new crowdfunding projects
- Development of new initiatives for the platform

The two founders are based in Malmö and Copenhagen. We work very closely together and expect the two interns to do the same. However, a lot of the dialogue is via Skype, so location doesn't matter that much. This is also a possibility to get some good connections and insight into the art and culture scene in DK/Sweden.

The internship is part-time and we will talk about how to shape and develop the internship. Because this is a non-profit initiative we cannot offer to pay you, but only to share our knowledge and experience. We will have a kick-off weekend together in January.
